



WEEKLY UPDATE: July 29, 2021

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. We have one employee who tested positive this week due to an exposure outside of the facility. Out of precaution, all staff and residents were tested and we are happy to report all remaining staff and residents are negative.

Clark County's positivity rate is currently at 15.8% and unvaccinated staff are tested twice per week per CDC recommendations. All staff continue to be screened and monitored for signs and symptoms of COVID-19.

Due to the increase in COVID-19 cases within our community, please adhere to the following visitation guidelines:

- Indoor and outdoor visits (weather permitting) are by appointment only as we have limited space for resident and family privacy.
- Please call Reception at 702-382-5580 to schedule your appointment.
- Please be on time for your scheduled visit as we are trying to accommodate as many families as possible with limited space.
- Please adhere to your scheduled appointment start and end times to allow all residents an equal opportunity to visit with their loved ones.
- Room visits will be allowed when families can show proof of vaccination. Only 2 family members may visit in the room at any time and visits are limited to 30 minutes.
- Facility will accommodate compassionate visits for our residents who are on Hospice.
- All visits are subject to cancellation pending staff and resident routine testing results.
- Please adhere to facility's screening process, mask requirement and social distancing expectations to keep your loved one safe.
- Noncompliance with these basic precautions will result in facility staff terminating the visit.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Please continue to check our website for weekly updates as well as notification of new cases. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.
